



Important notes

Below you will find a complete list with all the measures that are being adopted by the Macaronesia Wildlife Adventure team to address the COVID-19 situation on our sailing trips.

***IMPORTANT: COVID-19 test is requested before boarding to all crew members.**

As participating in the Macaronesia Wildlife Adventure Experience not only is a leisure trip but also contributes to the internationalization of the cooperating partners, as well as becoming a vehicle to contribute to the scientific study of the different flora & fauna species found inside that region, each participant will receive a letter signed by the project director. Hence, **travelling to the starting point and taking part in this sailing route will not suppose any legal problem when it comes to border movements.**

Measures on board

Control of the temperature of the skipper and the entire crew before boarding.

All prescribed hygiene materials will be provided and properly stowed on the ship, such as hydroalcoholic gel and soap for hand cleaning.

In addition to the usual cleaning of our boats, a comprehensive disinfection will be implemented before each shipment. The objective will be to decrease the possible viral load that could exist in each boat before the crew can be accommodated.

To ensure the adequate protection of the crew members, facilitating the washing of hands with disinfectant gel.



Ventilation will be increased whenever possible from the interior of the ship.

The bathrooms, kitchen and exterior will have dispensers for disinfectant gel, drying paper, and/or disinfectant solution. Cleaning measures shall be extreme.

A sign with all rules to be followed will be placed in a visible area inside the boat so each crew member can verify whenever it is needed.

What are the measures each crew member must comply with while being aboard?

Throw away any personal hygiene waste -especially tissues-, as well as PPE immediately to the trash garbage cans or containers adapted for this purpose.

Wash your hands thoroughly after sneezing, blowing your nose or coughing or touching potentially contaminated surfaces.

Wash your hands before entering the ship and when returning from shore.

Disinfectant soap dispensers will be available next to the sink.

Paper should be used for drying.

Keep cloths and scourers sanitized at all times and change them periodically.

Try to always keep the safe distance between other crew members inside the boat and try to avoid more than 2 people in the common area inside the boat.

Leave your personal belongings in the designated place (the skipper will specify where).

Do not touch your face.

Sneeze or cough with your elbow.

COVID-19 MEASURES



Do not share sunscreen or diving equipment.

After each meal, clean the table and the surfaces that have been touched as well as the kitchen.

Only the crew members who occupy the cabin will be allowed to enter it.

There will be a bottle of gel inside and outside.

Before opening the bathroom door, hands must be washed with gel.
